# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2022-2023



## President's Report 79<sup>th</sup> AGM of the WDSAC

Ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the 79<sup>th</sup> AGM of the Whangarei Deep Sea Angler's Club.

Once again, this year has presented challenges as we moved out of the COVID 19 cycle back to some form of normality across the country then as the real summer arrived, we experienced two cyclones and the effects of the La Nina weather pattern. Overall, however, the club has managed to consolidate its position despite the weather and other interruptions.

The financial position of the club has shown an improvement over the last year, with subscriptions, Bar takings and the Bistro being the biggest contributors.

Early indications that this year was shaping up to be a good fishing year were dashed with the cyclones, persistent Easterlies and poor weather that had an effect on our tournaments and the fishing overall.

### Tournaments

The committee has worked very hard to obtain new sponsors and maintain our existing sponsorship across all the tournaments. The weather meant that several tournaments and events had to be postponed and with a cluttered fishing tournament season this again presented some challenges for the committee.

We have had great support from our sponsors this year and if it was not for their support the tournaments would not have been what they were.

### Expenditure, changes, Repairs and Maintenance

The committee has had to be fiscally prudent over the year after COVID 19 impacted the club but not withstanding the difficulties presented by COVID the committee has still managed to address some much-needed changes.

During the year we invested in a new tent canopy for the outside area. The old one that had stood the test of time and whilst providing a much needed outside area had run its course and was quickly becoming unrepairable. The new canopy is impressive and has opened up the area by providing more light into the club. With careful management this canopy will be around for years to come.

We have replaced the old trophy cabinet with three glass cabinets that are now on display as people walk into the club. These back-lit cabinets truly showcase the club's history, and all the trophies are for everyone to enjoy.

The upstairs fish mounts have been moved down into the club and we have added the world record Striped Marlin to the wall as well. This just helps to showcase our club to visitors and guests alike.

Refurbishment of the upstairs function area 'The Lookout' has proved to be a worthwhile investment. We have hosted a large number of weddings; Christmas parties and corporate functions and it is anticipated the function room will continue to be well used and provide an income moving forward.

The club web page has been revamped and there has been a big push into the social media area where our Facebook profile continues to grow. This is an exciting area the office team are really keen to progress in as it gets our club out there not only nationally but internationally as well. Currently we have over 9,000 followers from around the world tapping into our site. A great example is from the video of Girl on the Gaf at our Nautigal tournament which was viewed by over 1 million people.

Repair and maintenance costs for the club are an ongoing issue with costs being up this year. With regular maintenance, identifying issues early and rectifying them quickly before they become a major problem will help to reduce costs overall.

I would like to acknowledge and thank all those members who have given their time and expertise freely to carry out repair work throughout the year, without their efforts the repair and maintenance costs for the club would probably be unsustainable.

Going forward we will need to make provision for repairs to the weigh station area and the safety rail along the front of the deck area as some of the structural areas need to be checked for integrity.

### **Future expenditure items**

The Bistro is a very popular eatery that's does an incredible job in a very confined space. As one of the major revenue providers for the club, the committee is looking at enlarging the Bistro area and has sought concept plans to be drawn up.

Refurbishment and modernisation of the bar area to provide a more efficient and safer work environment will be ongoing and financially challenging but is something the club needs moving forward in the future.

I know wherever he is, there will be a fishing rod next to him and a beautiful calm sea. Tight lines Jack, we miss you every single day.

## PETER HOULDING



Peter was born in Preston, England. His family migrated to New Zealand in 1956 settling in Auckland. He attended May Rd school and Mt Roskill grammar, where he was dux, played football for Auckland, and where he sat the NZ University Scholarship, coming 27th in the country. He returned to England in 1970, where we married.

As an adult he made his life in Wellington, where he ran and eventually owned, a very successful software company. After a severe illness in 2003 we returned to Auckland, then moved to Tutukaka in 2017.

He had a great sense of humour, was extremely well read, loved books and could find a passage in one of his books right up to his last days. He also appreciated fine works of art, historical maps, spicy foods for which he grew chillies, and fine whisky. He became an enthusiastic cook in later life. He had business connections in USA and made many trips there before retiring after which we travelled extensively seeing the rest of the world. In his last years here in Tutukaka he was happy and enjoyed relaxing at the Club and playing pool. He could be very charming, but on the other hand very critical, and was not known for suffering fools gladly.

Before his illness in 2003 – and occasionally after it, but with a little less vigour – he was a keen and capable fisherman, happiest hauling up blue cod in the Marlborough Sounds, or snapper in the Hauraki Gulf with a brother or brother-in-law. He made a number of attempts to catch big game (off NZ, Australia, Thailand and Hawaii) but was always unlucky.

He was also unlucky trying to catch trout in Lake Taupo, with one attempt memorably ending up with one son in the water, along with the escaped trout; and another attempt ending next to the boat ramp with his wife up to her knees in water in the back of the boat and Peter wondering why “someone” hadn’t checked the bungs.

He is survived by his wife Barbara, sons Anthony and Philip, and 5 grandchildren.

This year the tournament was divided into eight sections: HEAVIEST MARLIN - TAG & RELEASE MARLIN – ANGLER MOST POINTS GAMESHARK – HEAVIEST SHARK – SHORTBILL SPEARFISH – TUNA – MAHIMAHI – YELLOWTAIL and SNAPPER.

We also added a couple of creative challenges to add to the excitement of the tournament and a 4 Longest Kahawai extra addition to keep the anglers buzzing. Challenge One: Was to take a picture of a sneak attack water fight using the water guns provided by Arthurs Emporium. Challenge Two: Was to take a picture of your team dressed up in the Starter Bag hat and glasses provided by Arthurs Emporium.

The winners of our Creative Challenges were Team Darkside (Bailey Nicholls and Savannah Nicholls) who took out 3<sup>rd</sup>. We had a total of 1x Striped Marlin landed, 2x Striped Marlin tagged, 7x Snapper, 1x Yellowfin Tuna, 2x Yellowtail Kingfish, 3x Shark tagged, and 4x Shark landed for the tournament.

Angler Most Points for Game shark went to Junior Angler Frazer Donaldson for his 3 Bronze Whaler Sharks caught on BWANA II

Small Fry Gemma Drake reeled in a whopping 9.72kg Snapper on 8kg line which put her up for a pending NZ Record on the boat Idle Time and took out 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Small Fry Snapper section.



In the Junior Snapper section Jack Hay took away 3<sup>rd</sup> place with his 6.82kg Snapper on 8kg line. Sophie Douglas came in 2<sup>nd</sup> place with her 6.92kg Snapper on 8kg line. And 1<sup>st</sup> place went to Finn Marsland with his 7.10kg Snapper on 8kg line.

In the Yellowtail section we had two Small Fry members tag and release on boat Taniwha.

Kristin Ras secured 2<sup>nd</sup> place with her estimated 9kg Yellowtail and in 1<sup>st</sup> place Gwenivere DeLacey tagged her estimated 6kg Yellowtail. Kristin Ras also took away a Hard Luck Prize after a shark took her hard-earned Yellowtail right at the boat!



In the Tuna section Junior member Abbie Cathcart secured 1<sup>st</sup> place with her 30.8kg Tuna caught on Matatoa. Abbie also achieved 1<sup>st</sup> Place for the Heaviest Marlin landed section which weighed in at 95.4kg.

In the Tag and Release Marlin section Junior Sam Greensmith came in 2<sup>nd</sup> with his estimated

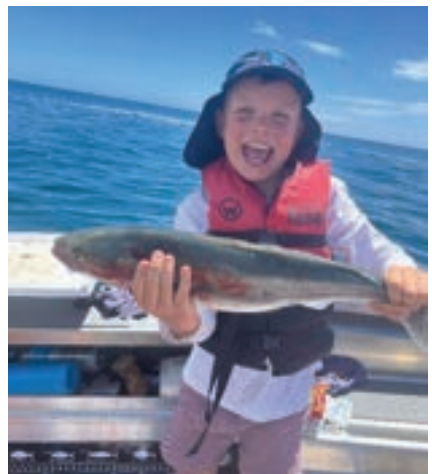
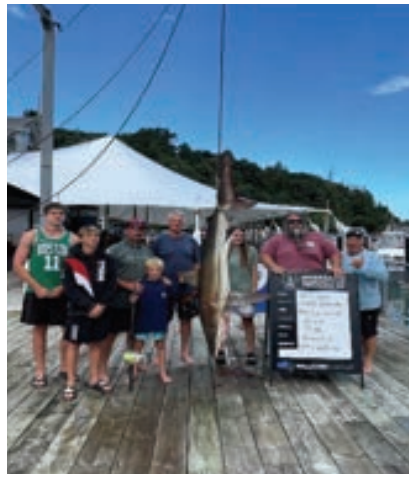
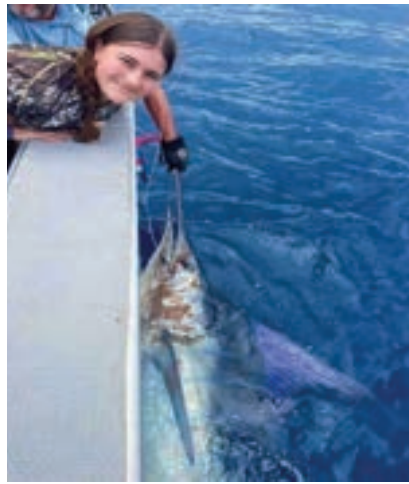

# CEDEX STEEL COMBINED TRADES TOURNAMENT 2023

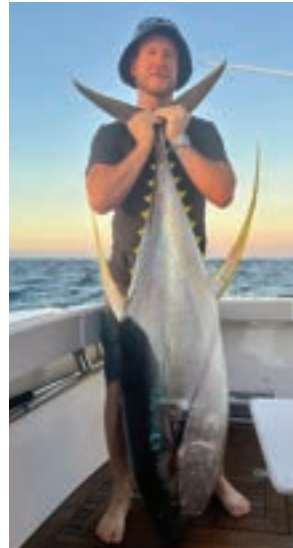
A great turn out with 52 teams and 145 anglers for the Cedex Steel Combined Trades tournament.

A total of 6 Striped Marlin were tagged and 2 landed. 3 Yellowfin Tuna, 3 Yellowtail Kingfish, 2 Mahimahi, 2 Snapper and 1 Broadbill Swordfish landed made for a couple exciting days.

Team WALK THE LINE did well in the Heaviest Yellowtail Kingfish section. Brent Klink secured 2nd place with his 13.6kg Kingfish. Teammate Kim Carthew went away with 1st place in the same section for his 17.5kg Yellowtail.

In the Heaviest Snapper Section Team SPACE COWBOY cleaned up. Dave Ryburn coming in 2nd with his 6.58kg Snapper with his teammate Simon Herbert bringing in his 7.26kg Snapper to take out 1st place.

Team CHOPPER took out the Mahimahi section with Glen Croft weighing in his 10.62kg stunner to take 1st place. Teammate Alex Douglas landed one weighing in at 8.76kg.



We had three Yellowfin Tuna come in this tournament. Team BLACKJACK angler Paul McLean weighed in his 1st place Tuna at 51.0kg. Team FISH ON angler Mike Van Engellent just missing out with his 47.0kg Tuna.

In the Tag and Release Marlin Team section we had in 3<sup>rd</sup> place Team BLACK JACK with angler Jeremy Pram's tag. In 2<sup>nd</sup> place Team MARLURE and taking out 1<sup>st</sup> place was Team HARLEQUIN.

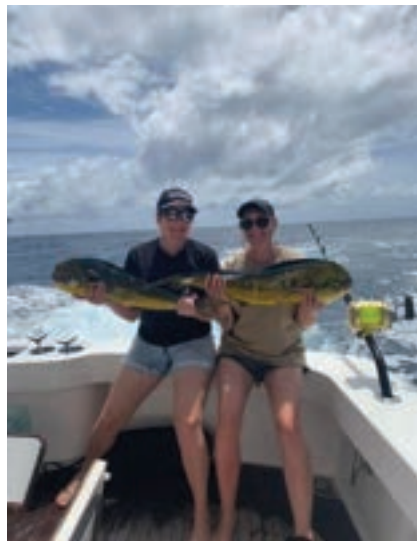
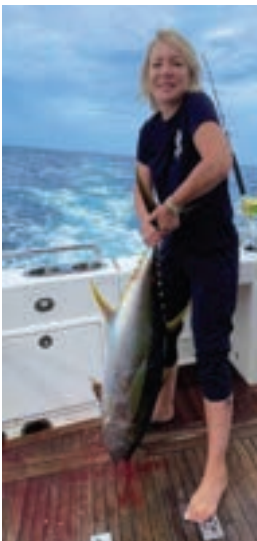

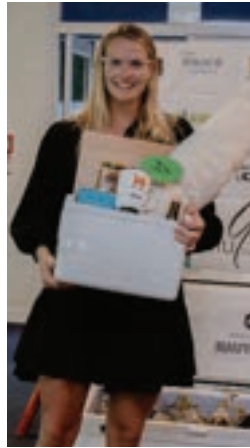

## Congratulations to our 2022-2023 Record Breakers!

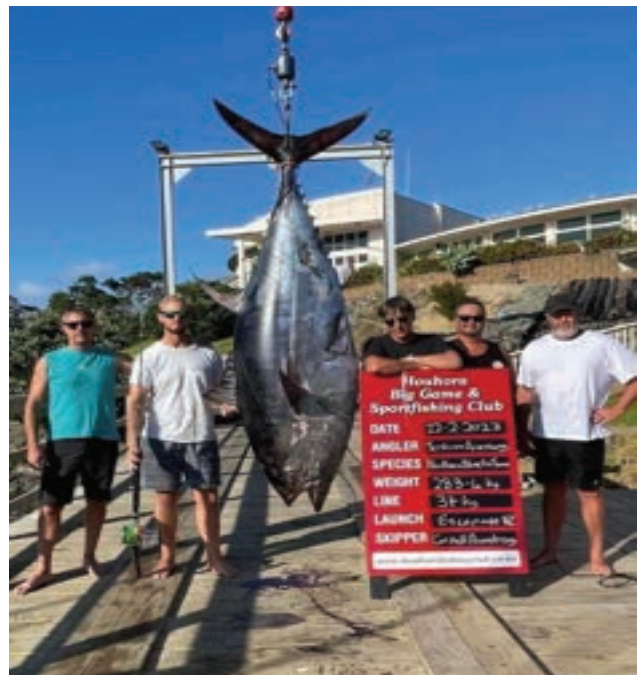
**MILA PULHAM** – Small fry Mila Pulham did an amazing effort 21 December 2022 landing a Snapper on 3kg line which weighed in at 9.08kg. This small fry line class did not have a previous record.



**JOSHUA ARMSTRONG** – Josh Armstrong caught this Northern Bluefin Tuna (Pacific Bluefin Tuna) 22 February 2023 only the 3<sup>rd</sup> of this species to be caught in Northland waters. It was caught on 37kg line and weighed in at a staggering 283.40kg.



**GEMMA DRAKE** – Small fry Gemma Drake was super stoked landing this Snapper in our Junior Tournament 22 January 2023 caught on 8kg line and weighing in at 9.72kg. This overtook Alexis Pulham's record (25.01.20 5.80kg) and is also a New Zealand Record.
